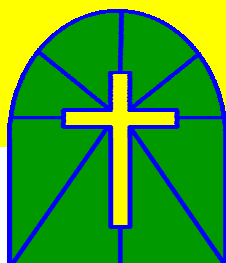

Summer Bonanza

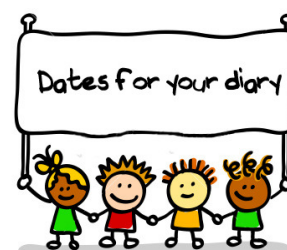
We also have our summer bonanza straight after school on Thursday 29th June, which will have stalls and games for all of you to enjoy.
