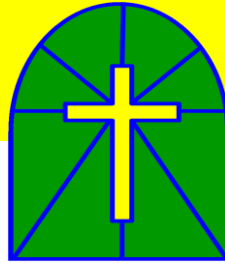

### OFSTED Inspection

### School Disco
