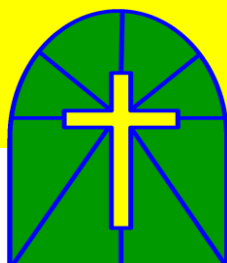

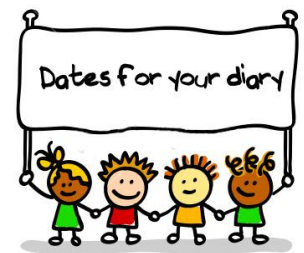

And Finally ... New policies from September

Mobile Phone Policy for Pupils

From September 2017, the School Governors have put in to place a mobile phone policy for pupils that states only Year 6 children will be allowed to bring mobile phones to school. This policy will be going out to parents of current Year 5 pupils next half term so parents can sign the agreement and agree to the policy.

Walking to and from School Policy for Pupils

From September 2017, the School Governors have put a policy in place explaining their expectation on pupils being allowed to walk to and from school without an adult or family member. They have made the decision that all pupils from Foundation stage to Year 5 will only be allowed home with a parent/carer, trusted adult or older sibling.

Only Year 6 pupils will be allowed to walk home on their own if parents agree to and return the permission agreement. The policy will be going out to all parents next half term.
